Setting the course for a safer future

**Road Safety Education Limited** is the leading provider of road safety education for youth in New Zealand. The flagship **RYDA Programme** is delivered each year to over 50,000 senior high school students from more than 650 participating schools across Australia and New Zealand.

*High teen crash risk is due to a number of factors, including a fundamental lack of driving skill. However, contrary to what one might think, the evidence suggests that poor vehicle control skills account for only 10% of novice driver crashes; the remaining 90% is accounted for by factors such as inexperience, immaturity, inaccurate risk perception, overestimation of driving skills, and risk taking (Edwards, 2001)*

Picking up from where RYDA leaves off, **Good2Go** is a unique opportunity for young drivers to work closely with specially trained instructors to hone their critical thinking, hazard perception, scanning, risk assessment and decision making skills behind the wheel in a real traffic environment.

This is essential learning that bridges the gap between vehicle control skills and the ability to make smart choices to stay safe on the road.



## Good2Go Sessions

Students take part an interactive workshop and three in-car modules.

- **MODULE ONE** A short classroom session explaining the 5 most common crash types and causes. Students also look at crash testing, safety ratings and complete a short risk-awareness activity.
- **MODULE TWO** Creating low risk driving habits, focusing on the importance of a safe following distance, minimum vision, and properly checking and monitoring blind spots.
- **MODULE THREE** Participants learn how to identify potential hazards and respond appropriately. Defining what a hazard is, and setting out usable methods of responding in a way that lowers drivers' exposure to harm.
- **MODULE FOUR** Considers how our decisions affect other road users, practicing gathering information early and making good decisions on the spot. Wraps up with a demonstration 'commentary drive'.

### Prerequisites to Good2Go



- NZ Learner or Restricted Licence
- Can safely operate a motor vehicle
- Can drive in moderate traffic on multi-lane roads
- Have some experience in complex traffic environments
- Have attended RYDA (preferable, not required)
